

Poster Presentation Guideline

- a. Poster presentation will be held on specified dates and locations.
- b. Abstracts are grouped by topic, numbered and listed in the program, and published in the abstract book (Respirology supplement).
- c. Each poster display should be confined within the limits of the area assigned:
- d. Size: depends on equipment and space of the Congress venue
(use double adhesive tape)
- e. Portrait Orientation
- f. The display should include:
 - 1) Title, author(s) and institution
 - 2) Short summary
 - 3) Introduction to background and objectives
 - 4) Description of the methodology
 - 5) Summary of results
 - 6) Conclusions
 - 7) Tables, graphs and pictures (coloured, if possible)
- g. The text of the display should be readable from a 1-meter distance
- h. Authors shall install and remove their posters according to the schedule assigned by the Congress Secretariat
- i. Authors should be available at his/her poster during any allocated poster sessions. Session will be limited to maximum of 3 minutes per poster and will be led by the facilitator.
- j. Poster presenting author must decorate Disclosure Slide sent by the Congress Secretariat on their presentation posters.
